Wells Branch moves to one day a week watering on Sept. 6

Starting Tuesday, September 6, Wells Branch residents and commercial customers will only be allowed to water one day a week.

In an effort to support water conservation efforts during the drought, the Wells Branch MUD Board voted to adopt the same Stage 2 water restrictions as the City of Austin.

Mandatory Stage 2 Water Restrictions

Residential Odd Addresses Saturday	Residential Even Addresses Sunday	Commercial, Multifamily Odd Addresses Tuesday	Commercial, Multifamily Even Addresses Friday
Automatic irrigation systems: Before 10 a.m.			
Hose-end sprinklers, soakers: Before 10 a.m. or after 7 p.m.			

Stage 2 Restrictions include:

- Watering allowed 1 day per week for all Wells Branch customers
- Hand-watering allowed anytime
- No automatic-irrigation after 10 a.m. on designated watering day
- Vehicle washing on designated day before 10 a.m.
- No charity carwashes
- No automatic fill valves for pools or ponds
- No outdoor fountains except to provide aeration for aquatic life
- No water to be served at restaurants unless requested
- No washing of sidewalks, driveways, parking areas or other paved areas

To ensure that all customers follow these restrictions, violations will result in an official warning, followed by a citation for second offenses.
