STAGE 2 MANDATORY WATER RATIONING IN EFFECT**

Due to the extremely dry weather conditions affecting Central Texas water resources, Wells Branch MUD has declared Stage 2 mandatory water rationing effective immediately.

**Stage 2 Mandatory Water Restrictions** require residential and commercial water customers to follow a two times a week watering schedule on their designated watering days.

- Residential customers with even number ending addresses: Sundays and Thursdays.
- Residential customers with odd number ending addresses: Saturdays and Wednesdays.
- Commercial Customers: Tuesdays and Fridays.

**Stage 2 Mandatory Water Restrictions also:**

- Limits automatic irrigation systems to operate on designated days only between the hours of 7:00 PM to 10:00 AM.
- Limits residential vehicle washing to hand held bucket or handheld hose equipped with a positive shut-off nozzle only on designated days between the hours of 7:00 PM to 10:00 AM and prohibits charity car washes.
- Automatic fill valves for pools or ponds should be turned off.
- No outdoor fountains should be used except to provide aeration for aquatic life.
- No water to be served at restaurants unless requested by the customer.
- No washing of sidewalks, driveways, parking areas or other paved areas except to alleviate an immediate health or safety hazard.
- Handheld hoses with positive pistol grip nozzle or other device that automatically shuts off water flow or handheld buckets can be used anytime.

To ensure compliance, these restrictions will be enforced. Violations may result in fines of \$200 for a first offense, \$500 for a second offense, and termination of water service for a third offense.
